They were **shot** in **Carthage jail**, on the 27th of June, 1844, about five o'clock p.m., by an **armed mob**—painted black—of from 150 to 200 persons. Hyrum was shot first and fell **calmly**, exclaiming: I am a dead man! Joseph **leaped** from the **window**, and was shot dead in the attempt, **exclaiming**: O Lord my God!

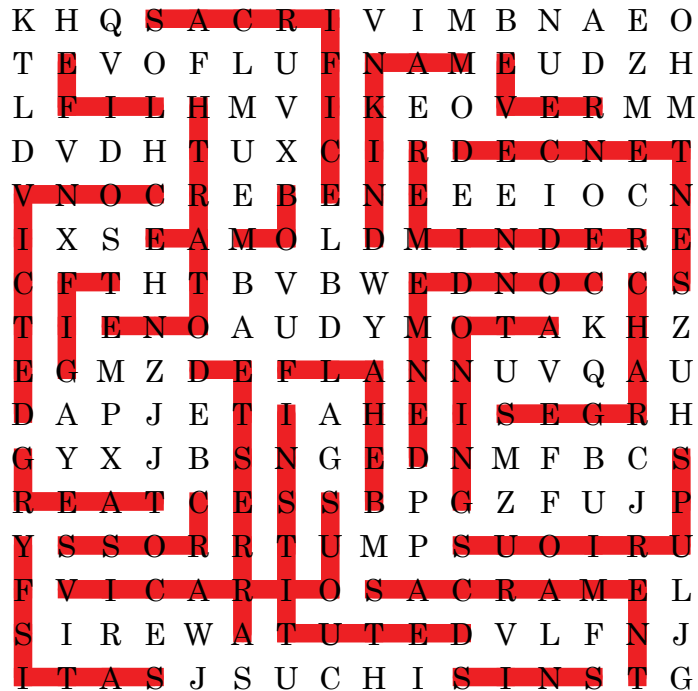
