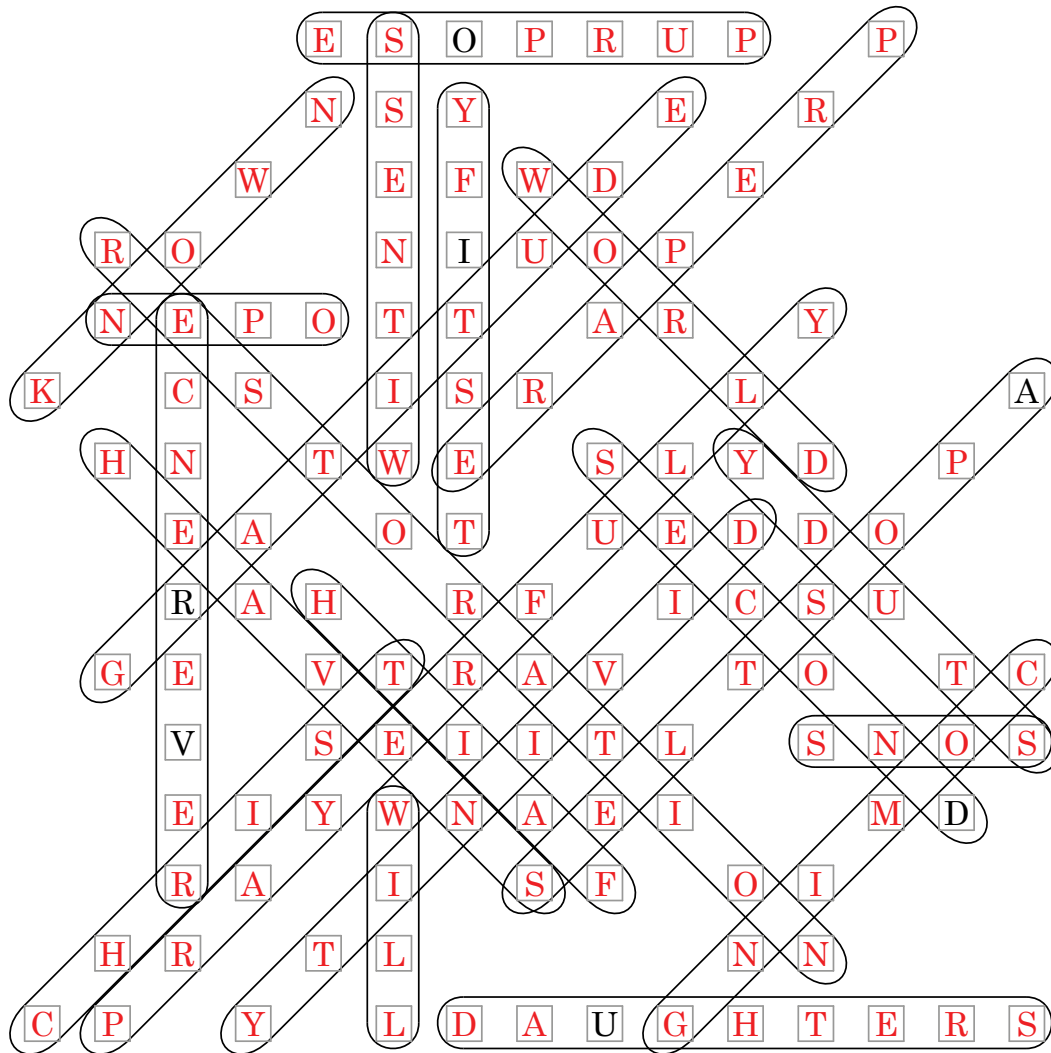
The Restoration of the Fulness of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
