

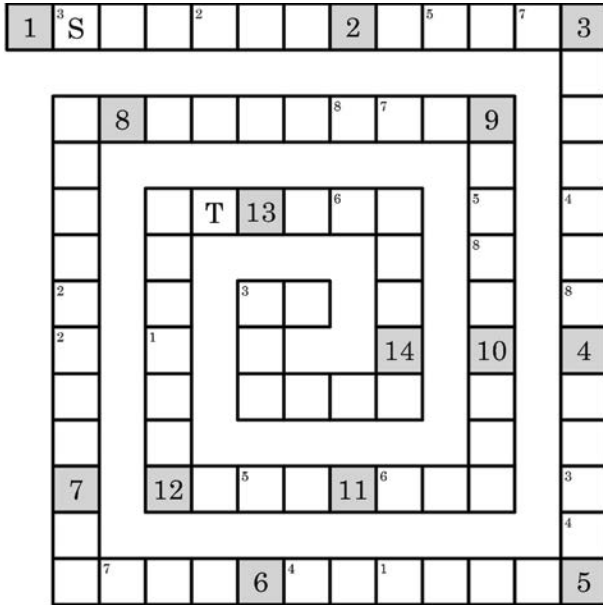

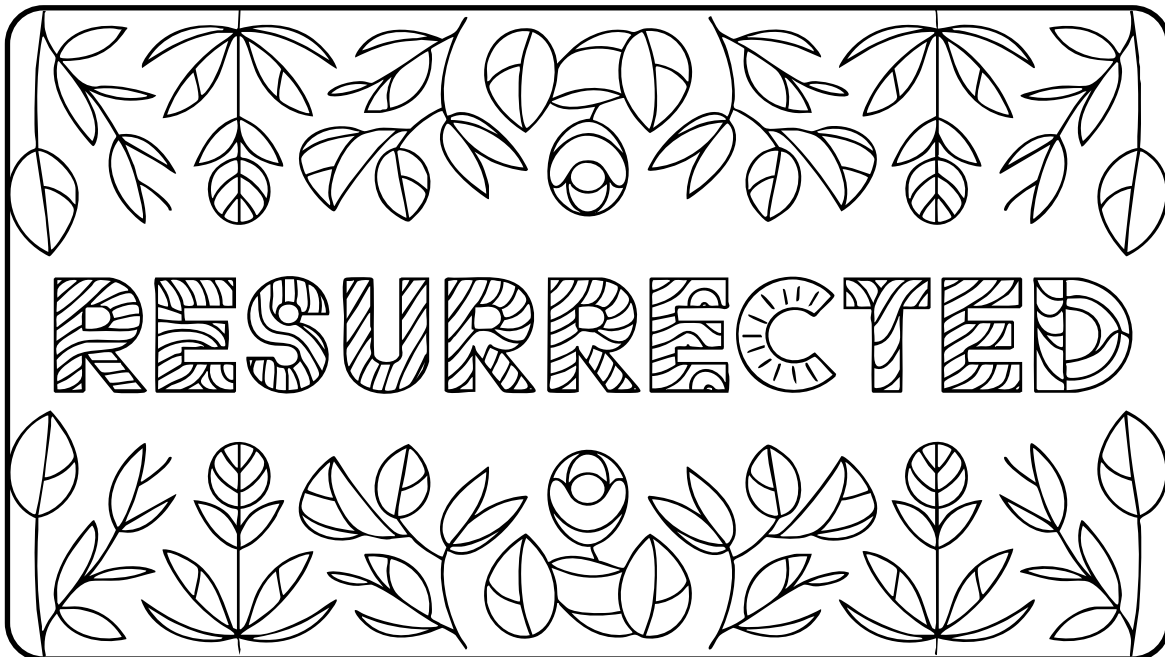
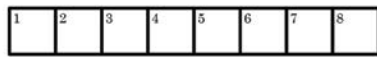
Word Spiral

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Word Angles

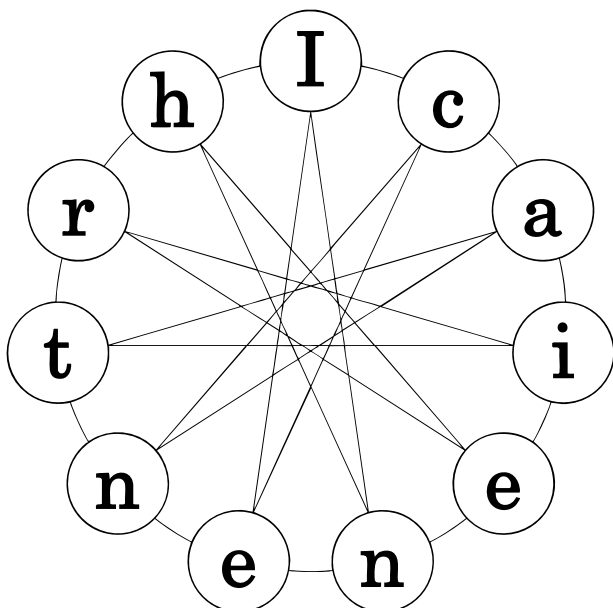

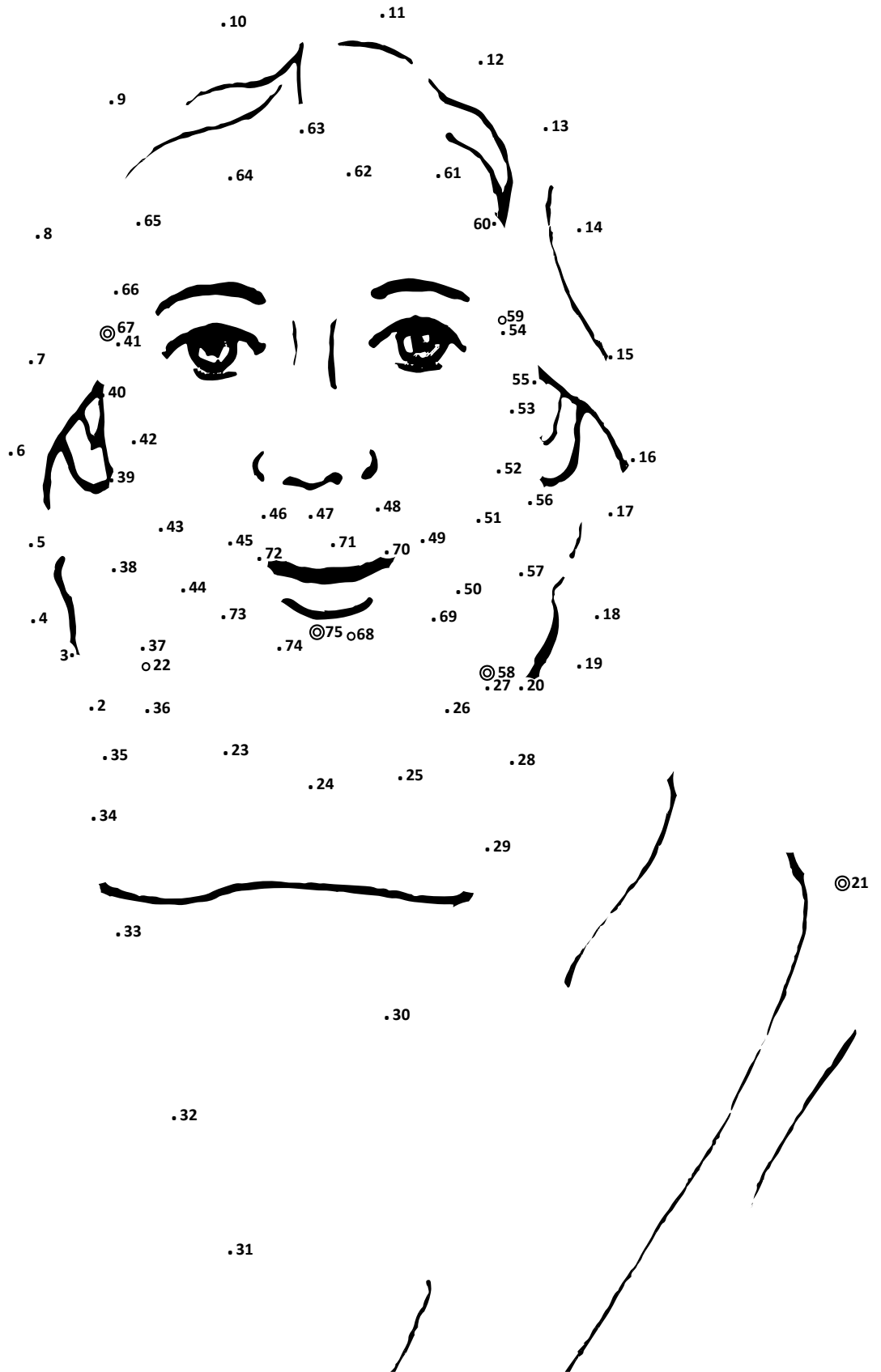
Word Star

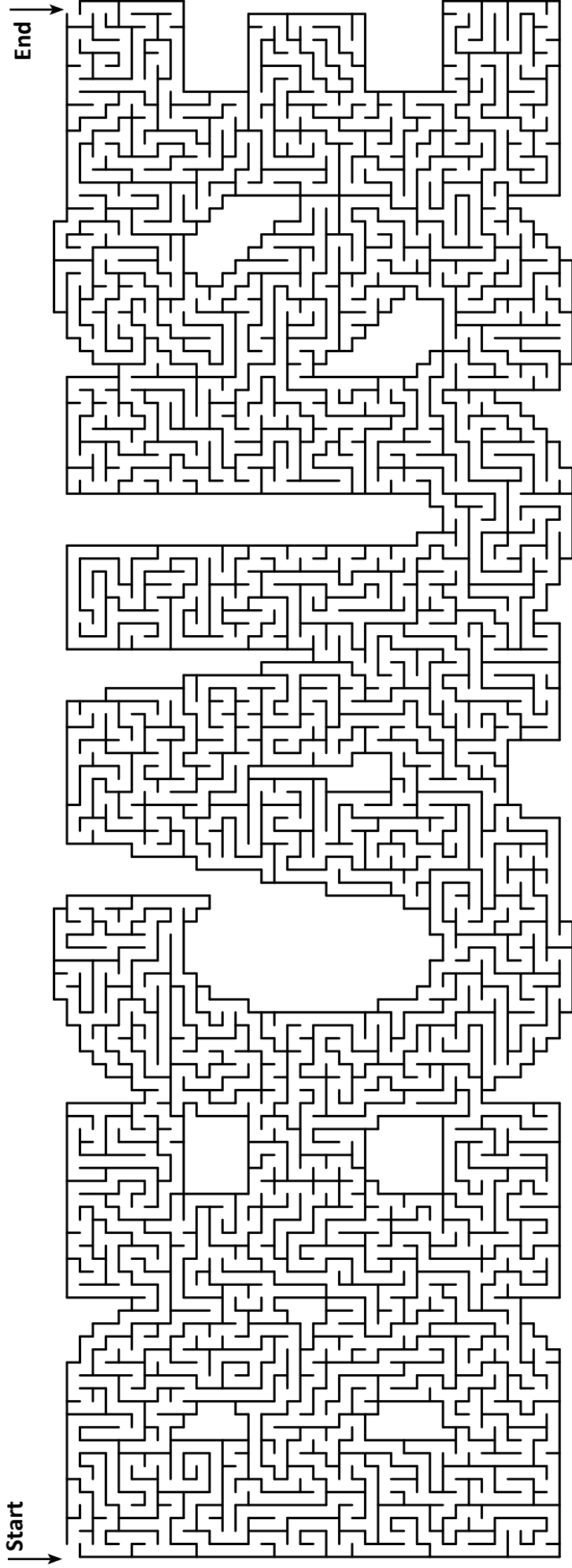

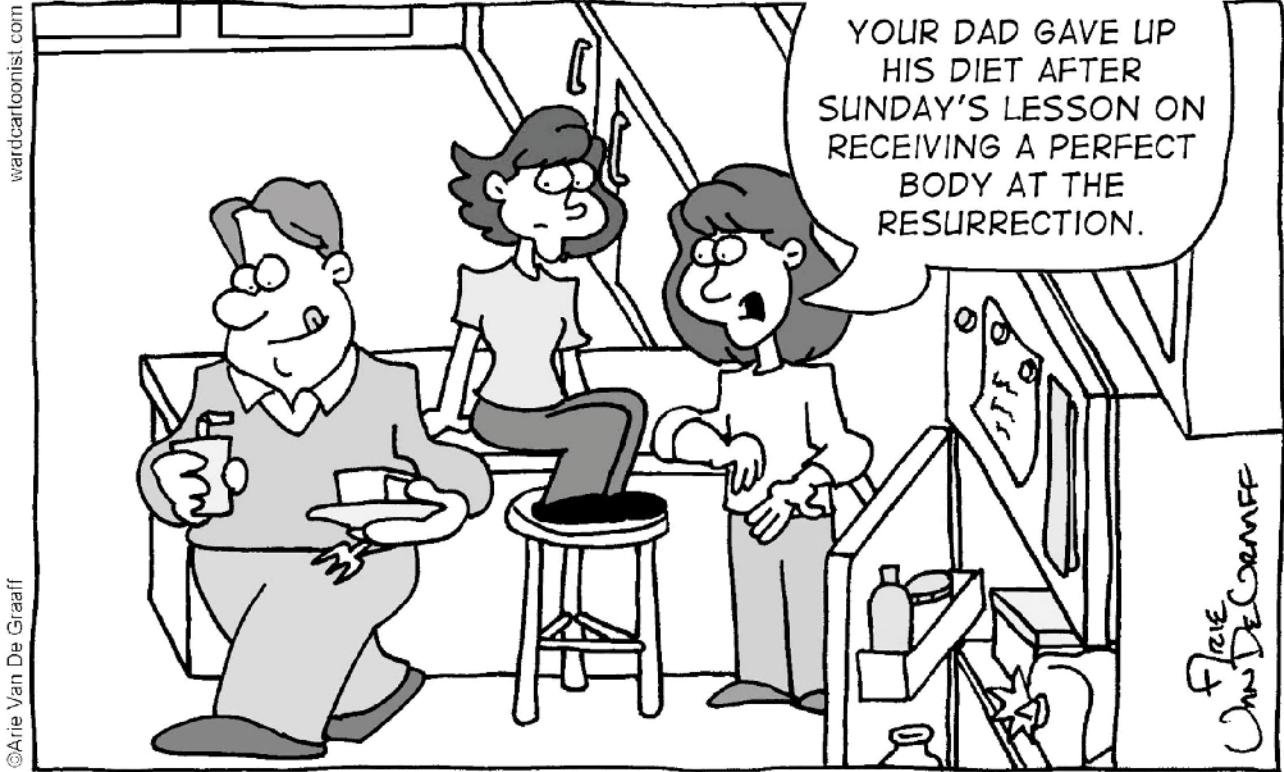
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Letterbox Puzzle
