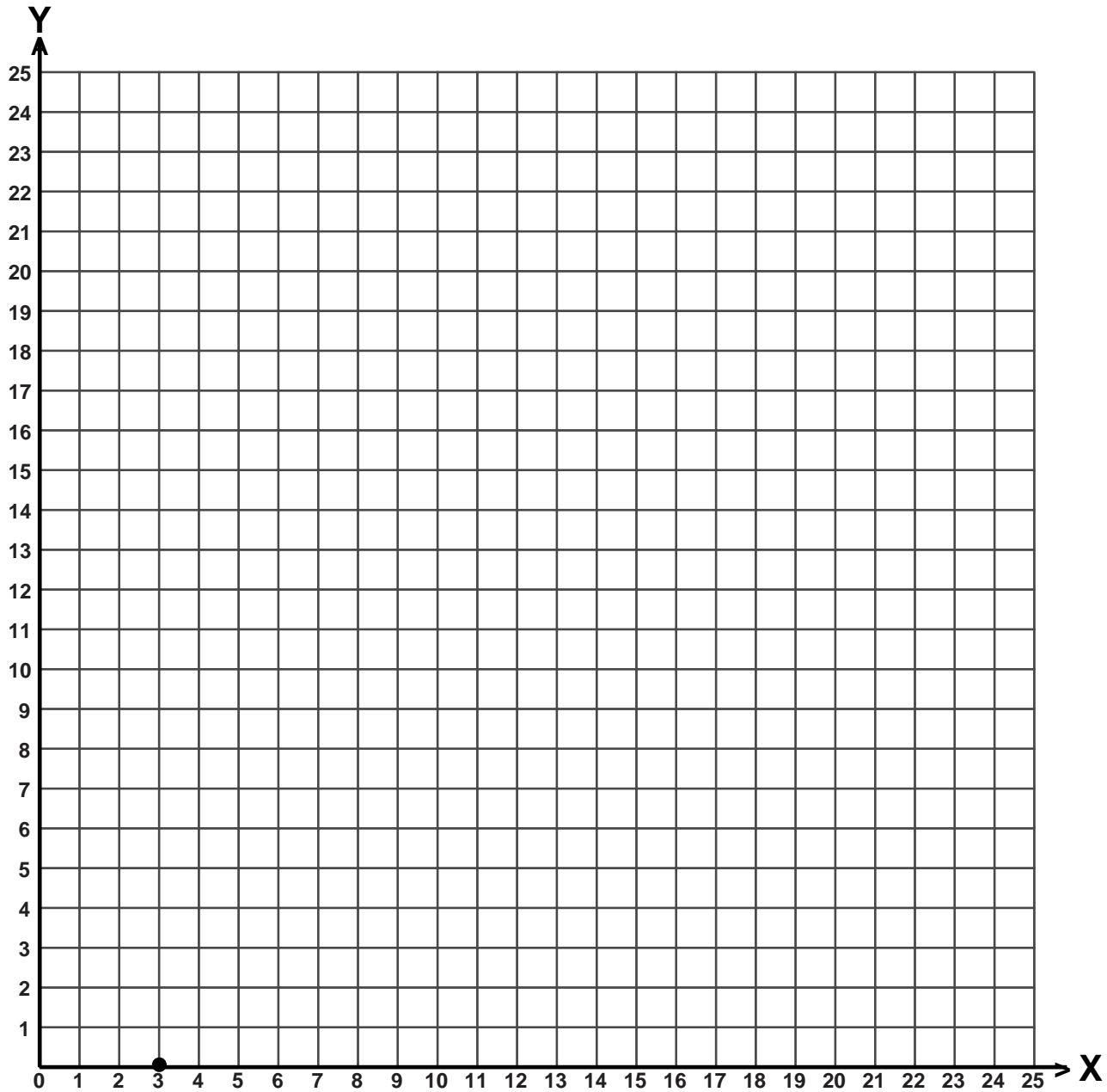


Mystery Picture Graph

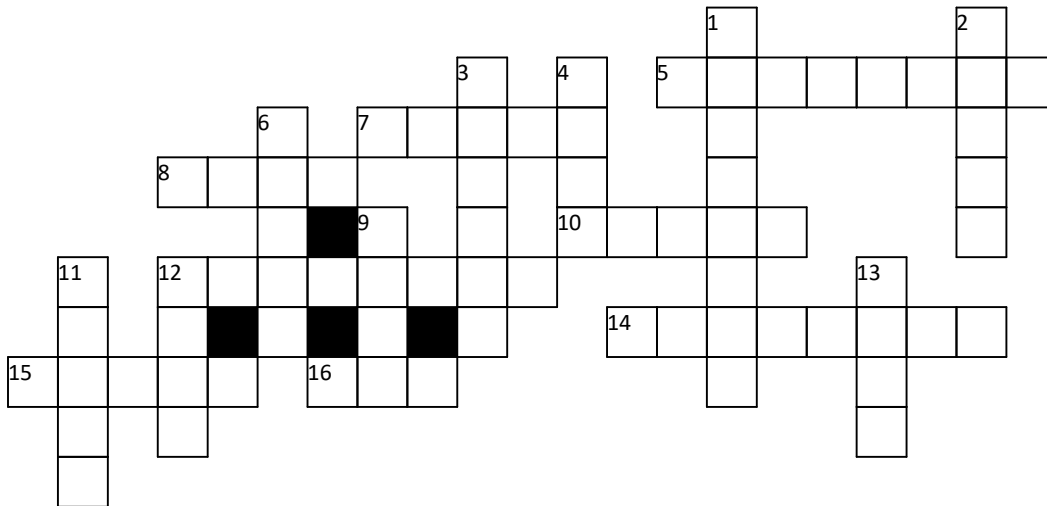
