

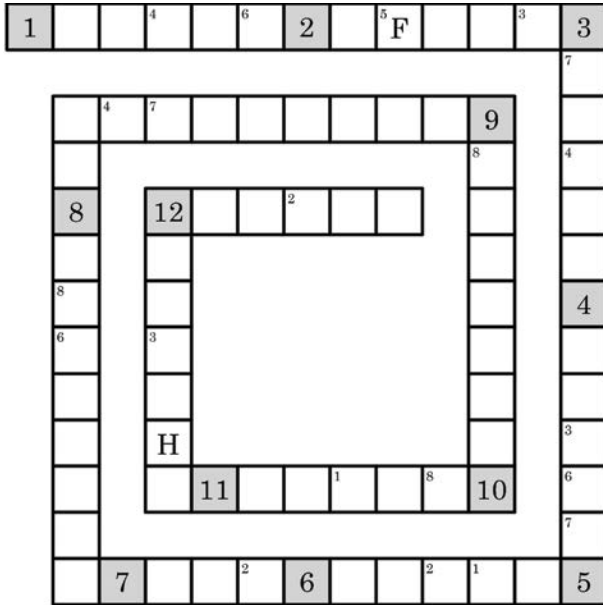

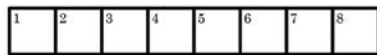
### Word Spiral

#### Doctrine and Covenants 86:5–7

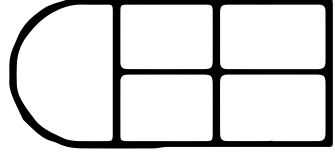

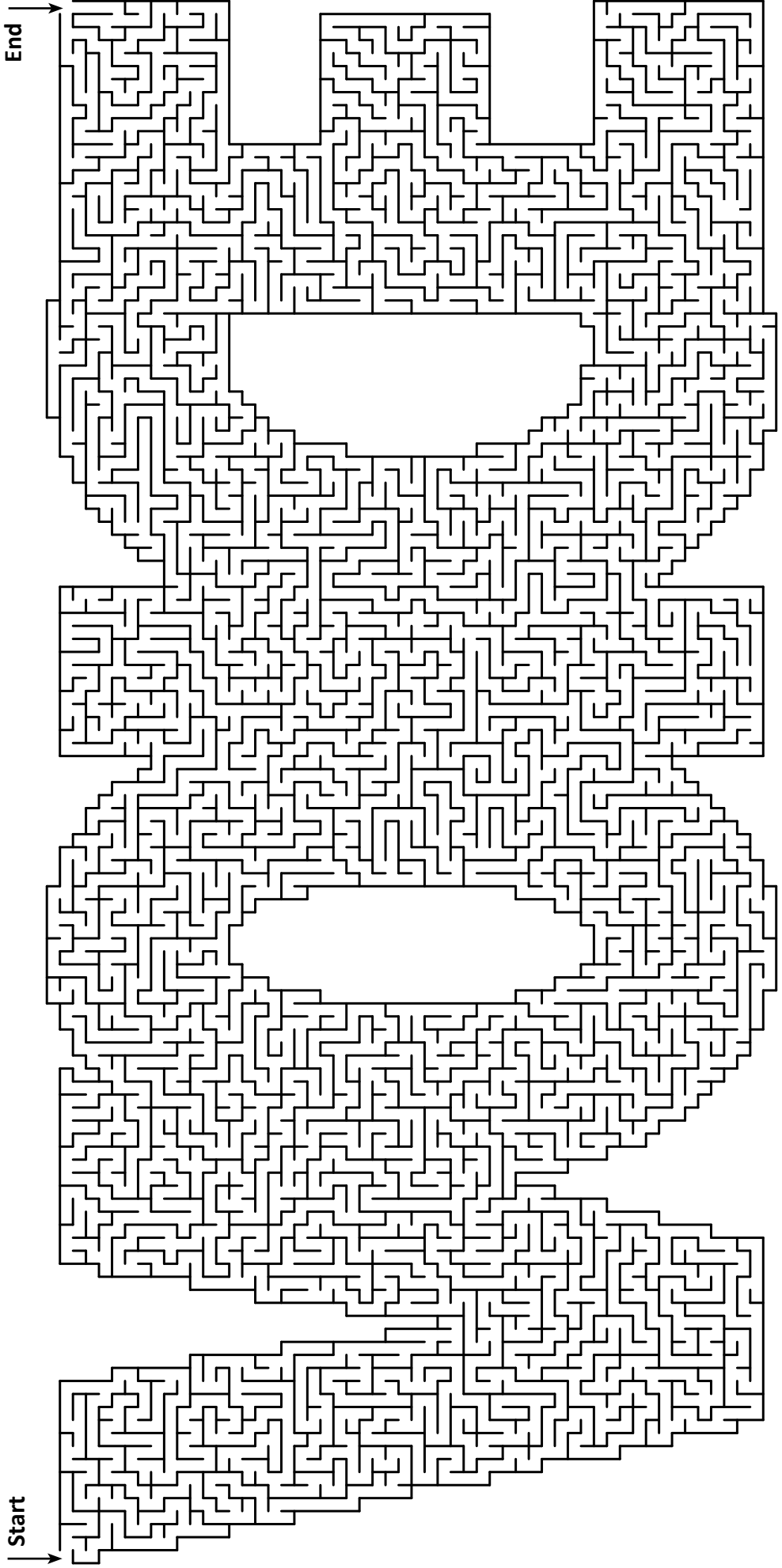
