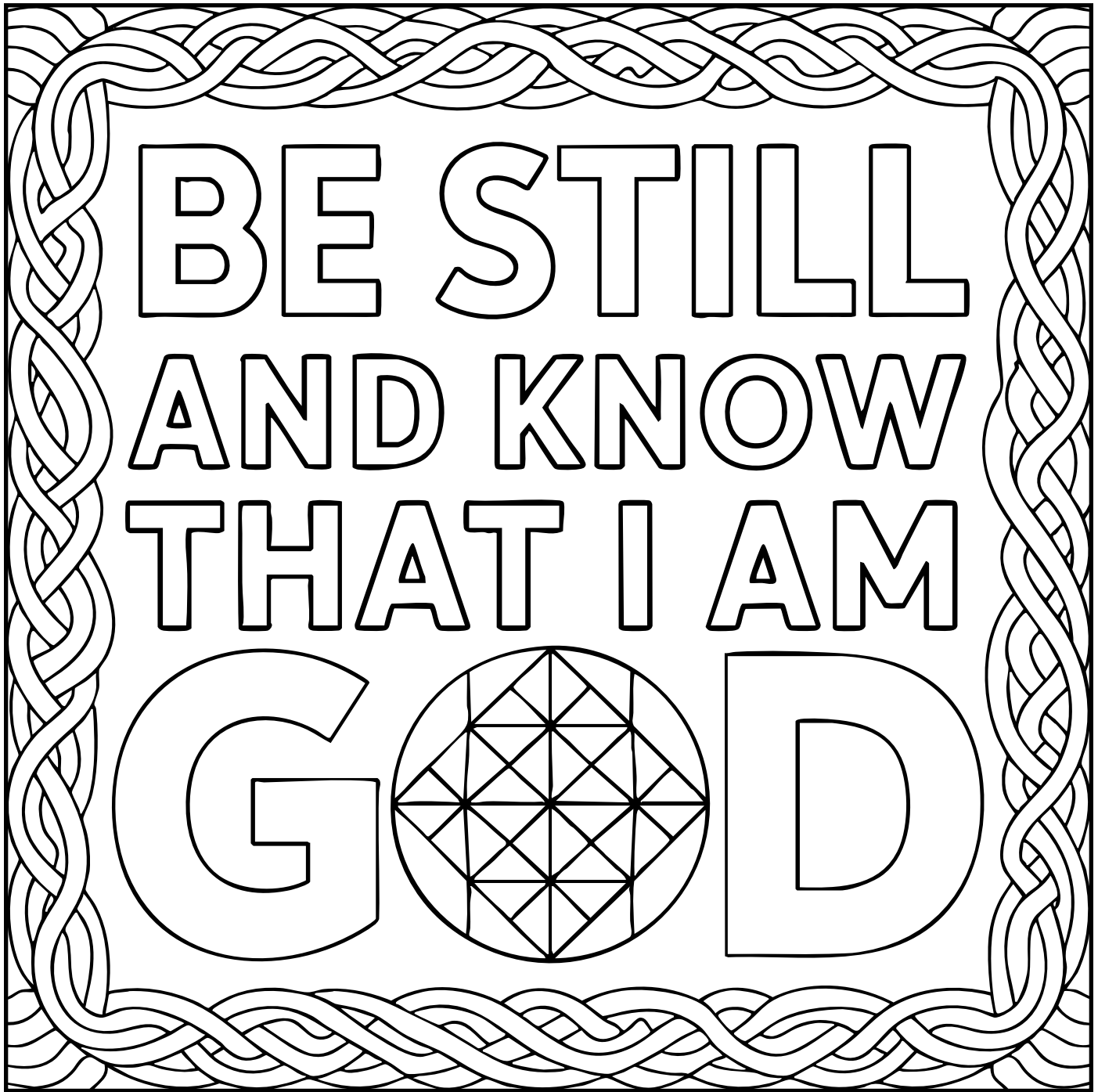

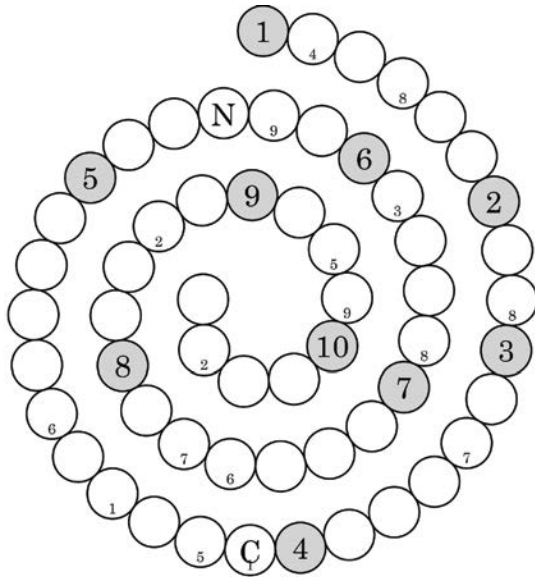

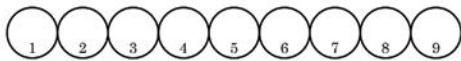
Word Spiral

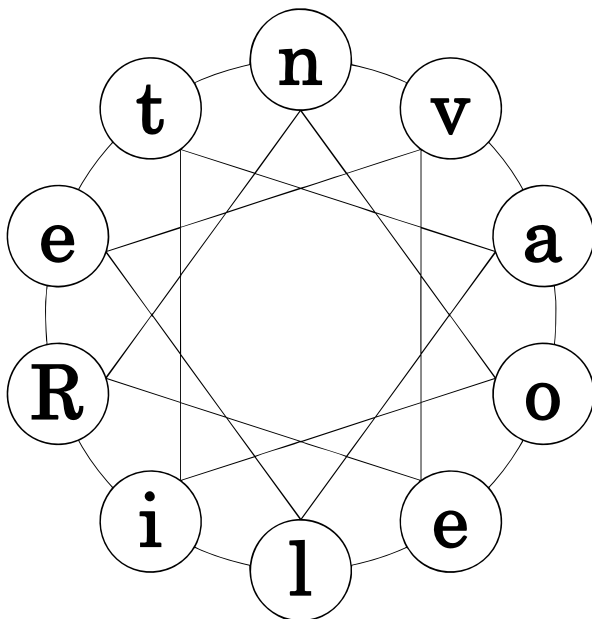

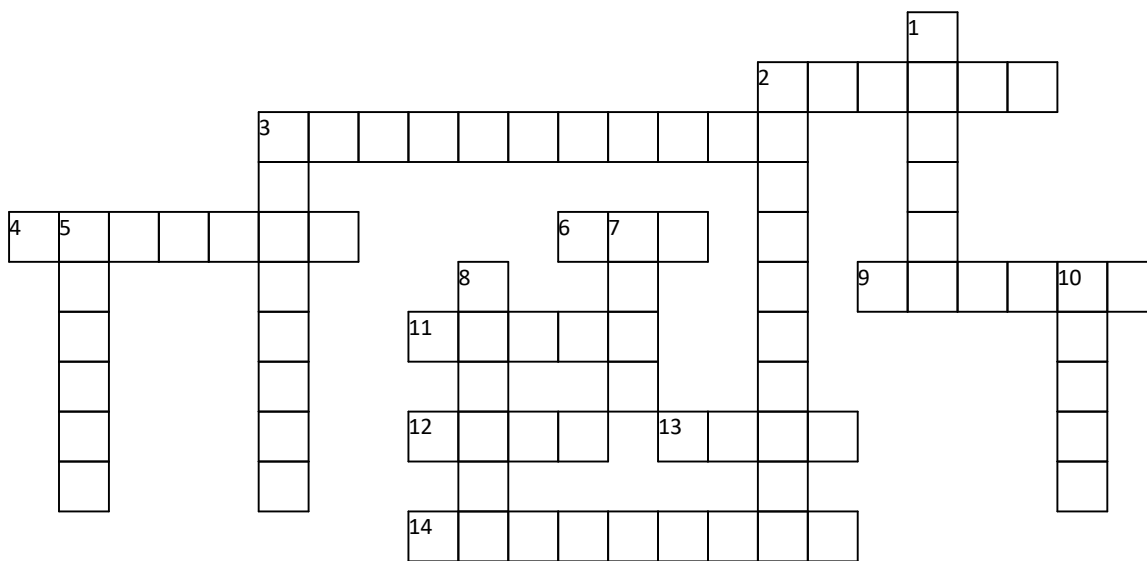
