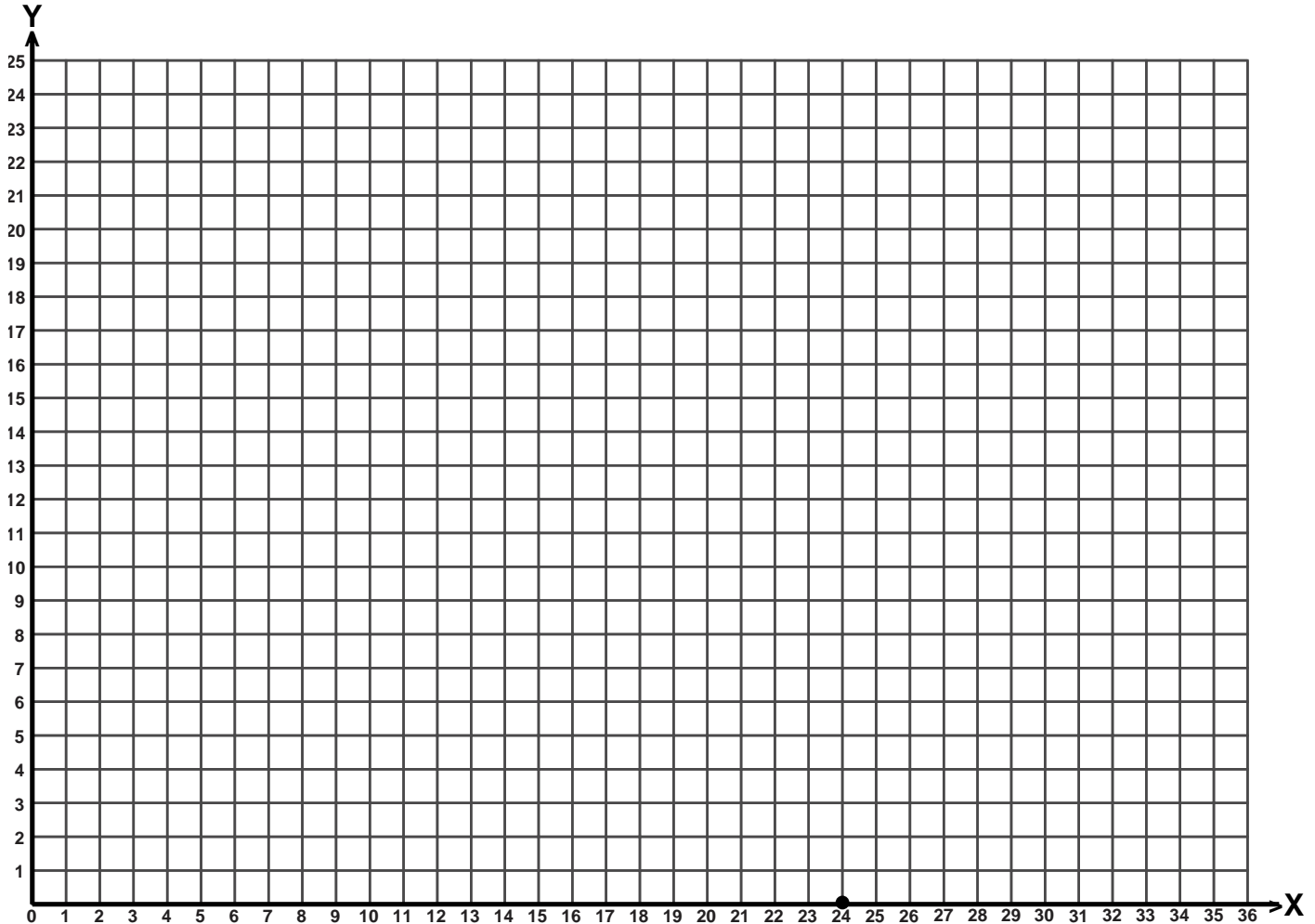

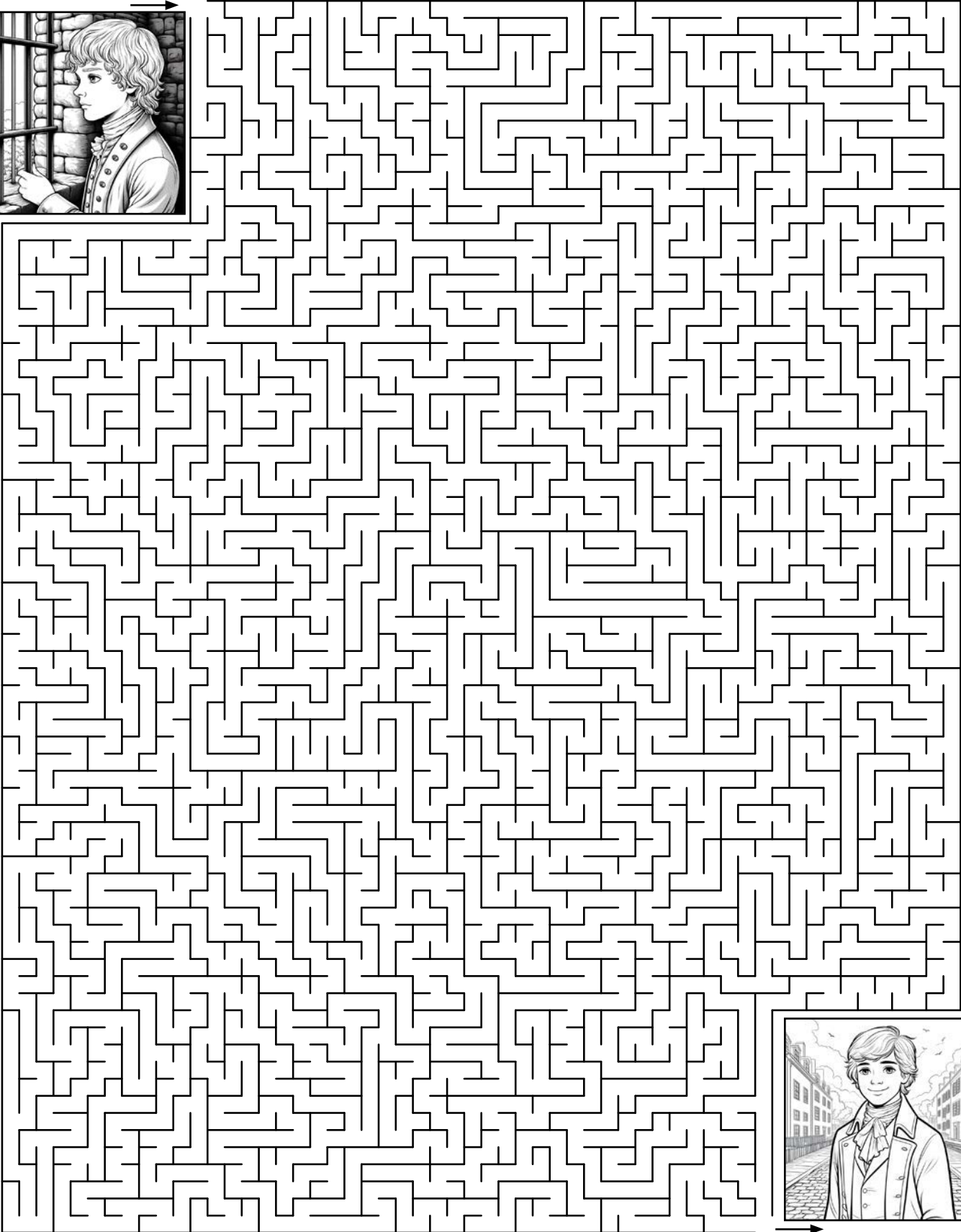

Joseph Smith was unjustly imprisoned in Liberty Jail. Can you help him escape to Nauvoo by traveling through the maze?



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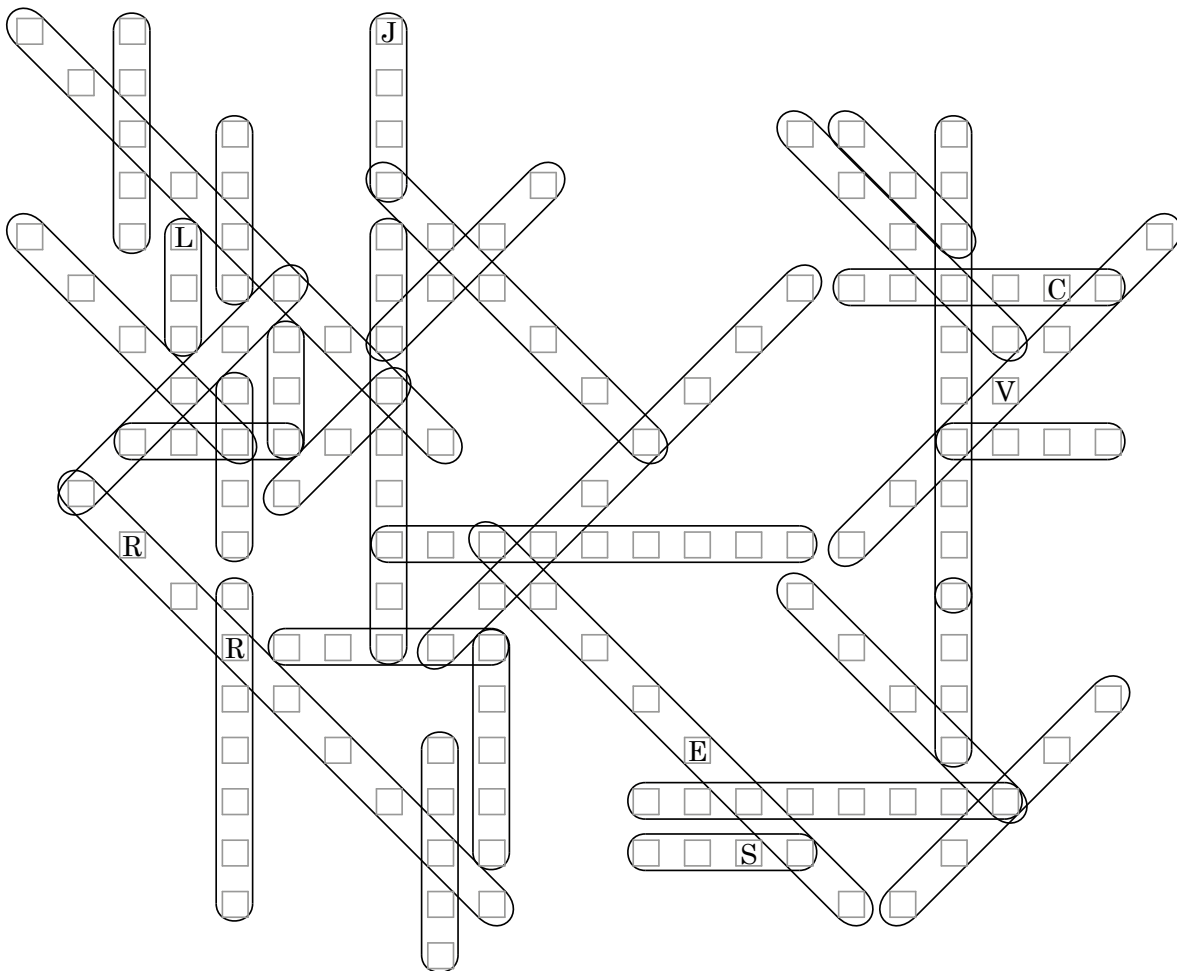
