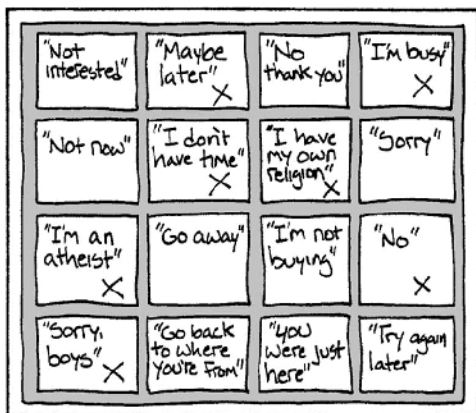
Wacky Word Trails
