

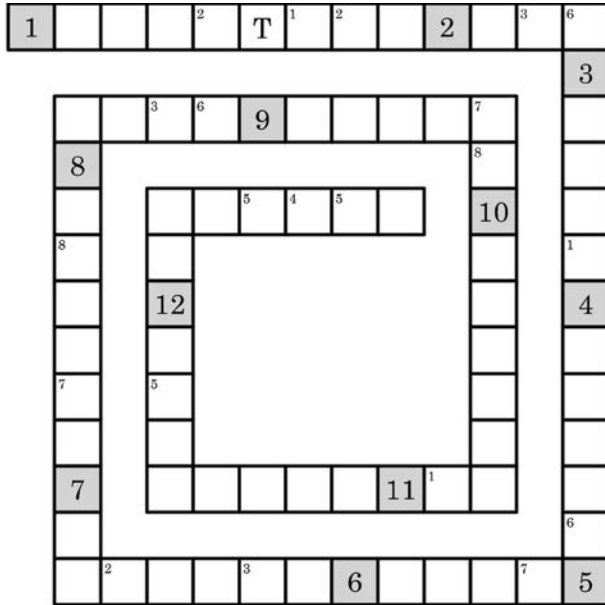

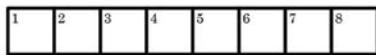
### Word Spiral

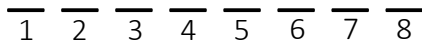

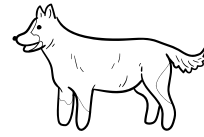

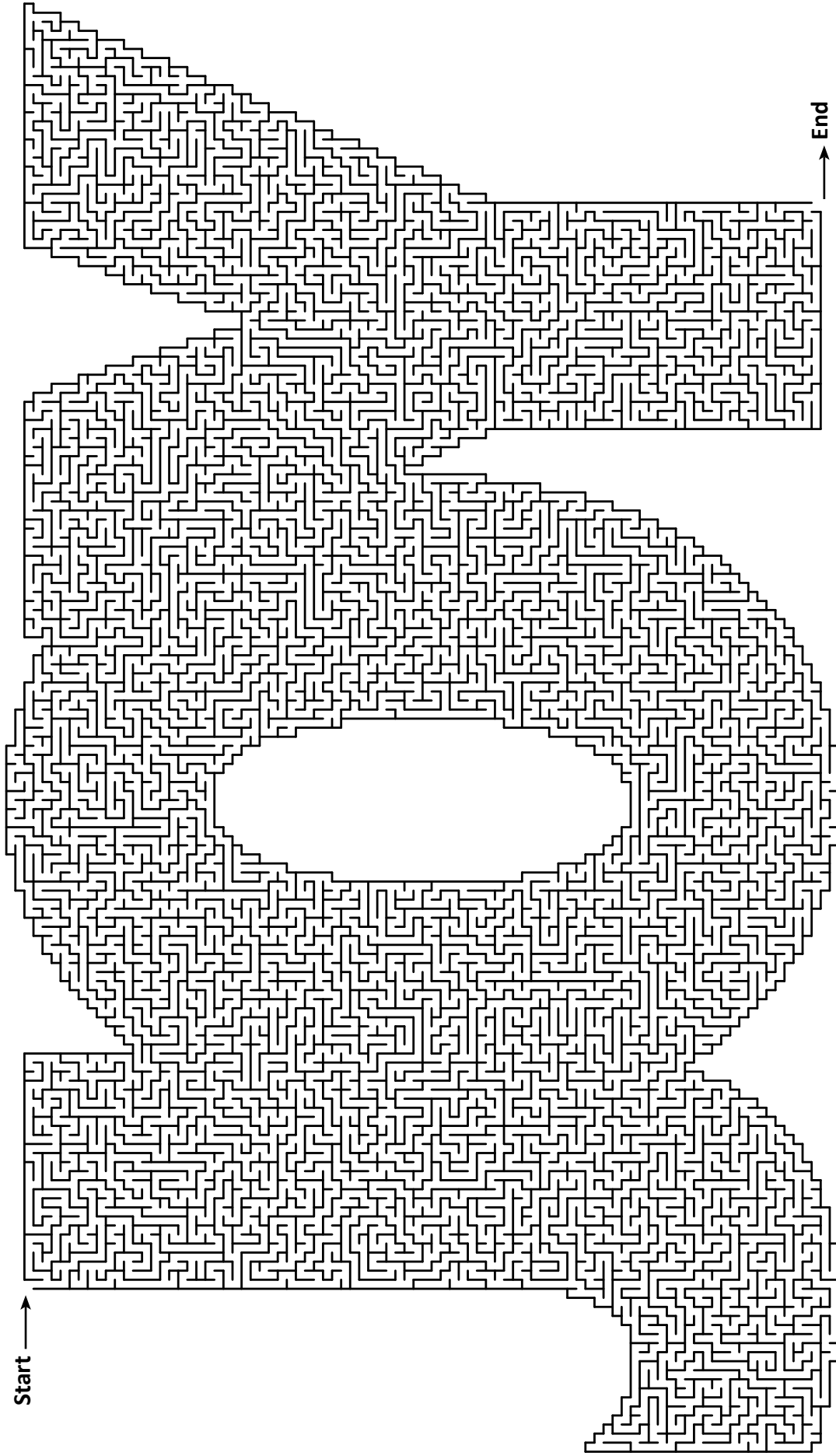
