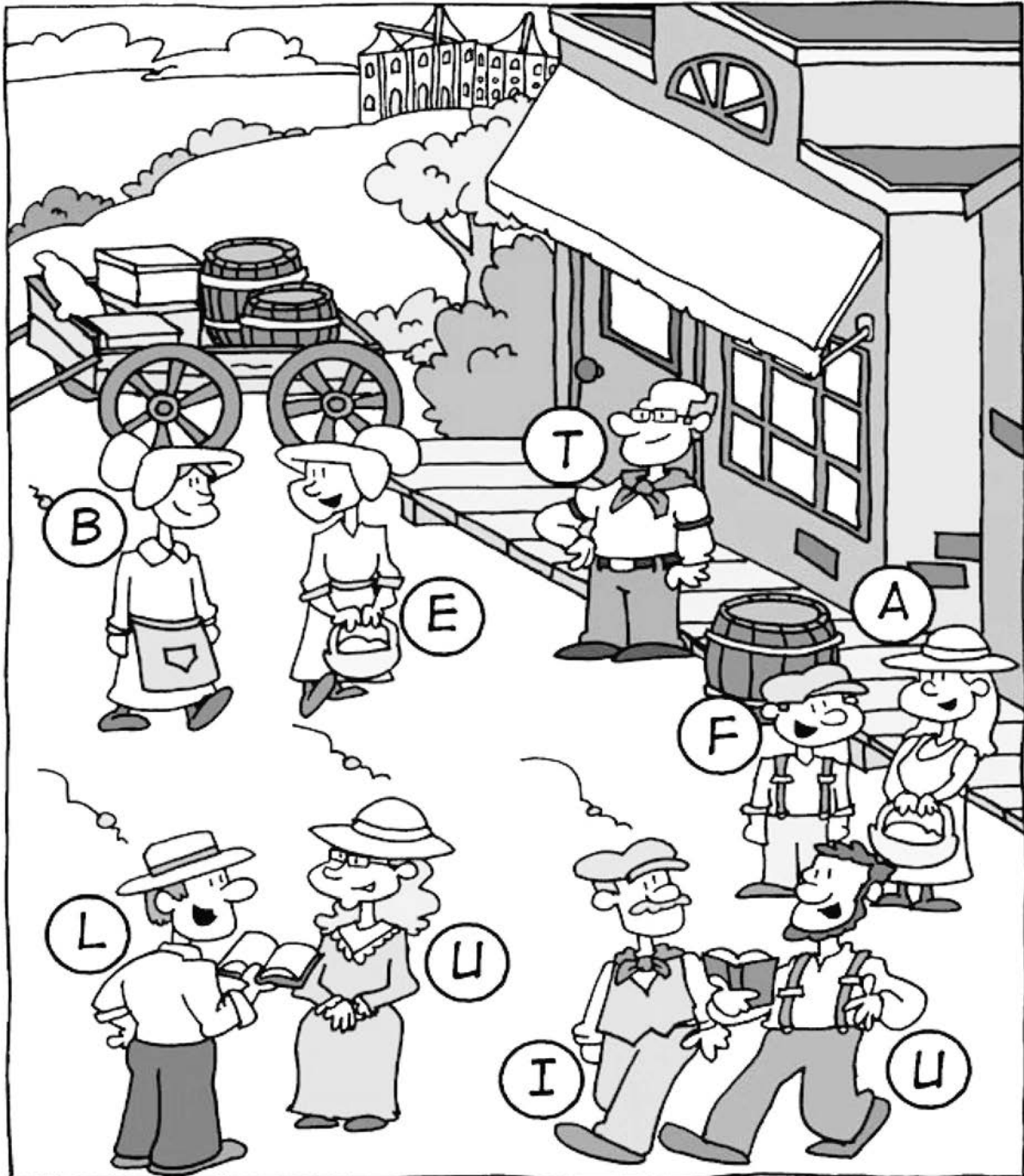

Write *B* and *E* in the spaces below. Then find out what person E has in common with another person in the picture. Continue until you have used all the letters.



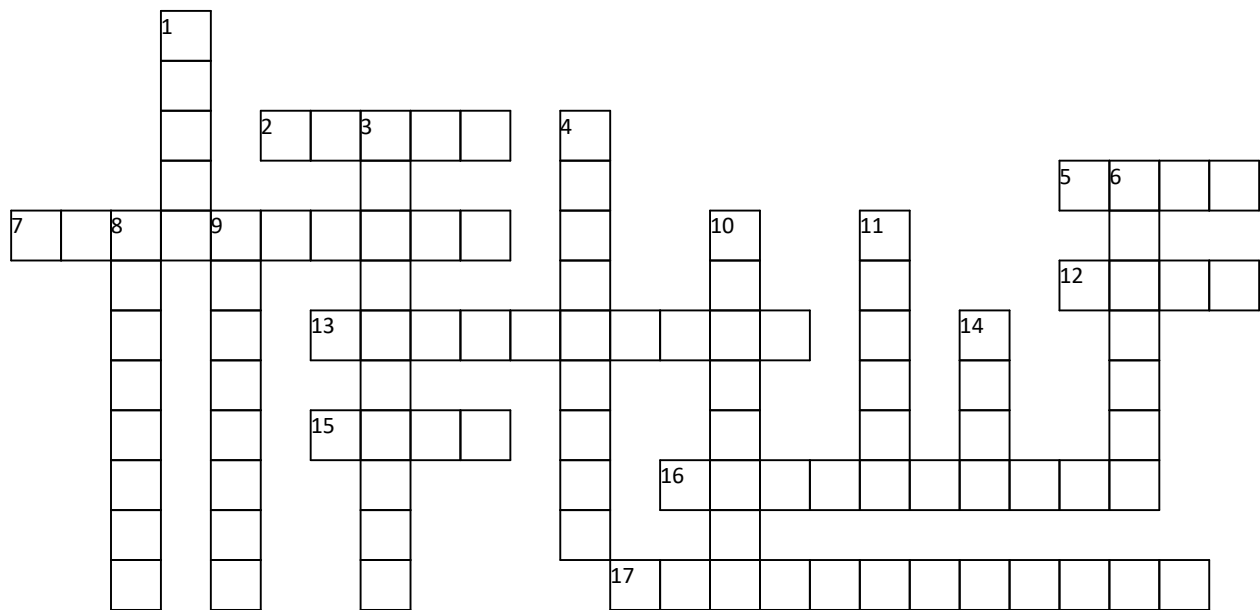
